

Optional Addition to CNT I - Microcurrent

Become a CNT I Microcurrent Trainee

Prerequisite:

- CNT I Trainee

Apply in writing for study and training

CNT I Microcurrent Course: Attend your first 10-hour CNT I Microcurrent course. Teachings of CNT I Microcurrent techniques including anatomy taught by a CNT Microcurrent Teacher or a CNT I Senior Teacher (Key CNTST1&T1m)

Study textbooks:

Result: CNT I Microcurrent Trainee

Allows to collect case studies of approx. 1-hour sessions

Within 24-months collect 70 Microcurrent case studies. 60 Can be done in a sequence of 12 x 5 sessions and 10 can be done in single sessions.

Become a CNT I Microcurrent Practitioner

Prerequisite:

- Certified CNT I Practitioner
- CNT I Microcurrent Trainee

As a CNT I Microcurrent Trainee, apply in writing for study and training

CNT I Microcurrent course: Attend a second 10-hour CNT I Microcurrent course, taught by a CNT Microcurrent Teacher or a CNT I Senior Teacher (Key CNTST1&T1m)

Case studies: When trained with local CNT Teacher, send case studies min. 2 weeks before second CNT training to your CNT Teacher by

registered mail or scanned. For attending training with travelling CNT Teacher present on arrival of the course 70 case studies in CNT I m

Evaluation: CNT Senior Teacher or CNT I Microcurrent Teacher, supervised by CNT I Senior Teacher (Key CNTST1&T1m)

Result: Certified CNT I Microcurrent Practitioner
Allows to work as a CNT Microcurrent Practitioner on students and clients
Profile as a CNT I Microcurrent Practitioner is added to the UHT Instructor-Directory (Key CNTP1 m)

Become a CNT I Microcurrent Teacher

Prerequisite:

- Certified Universal Healing Tao Instructor with keys BA, IS1, HL
- CNT I Teacher
- Work as an active CNT I Microcurrent Practitioner for minimum 2 years

As a CNT I Microcurrent Practitioner apply in writing for

Assisting: Participate as an assistant in a 10-hour CNT I Microcurrent course, taught by Grandmaster Chia or a CNT Senior Teacher (Key CNTST1&T1m)

Case studies: When trained with local CNT Teacher, send case studies min. 2 weeks before second CNT training to your CNT Teacher by registered mail or scanned. For attending training with travelling CNT Teacher present on arrival of the course 100 case studies in CNT I m

Evaluation: Grandmaster Chia or by 2 CNT I Senior Teachers (Key CNTST1&T1m)

Result: Certified CNT I Microcurrent Teacher
Allows to teach and educate students in CNT I Microcurrent and evaluate student under supervision of a CNT I Senior Teacher (Key CNTST1&T1m)
